Notice Periods - Teachers



The minimum period of notice to which you are entitled is:

either:

Two months notice and in the Summer Term 3 months notice, terminating at the end of a school term. For the purpose of these arrangements the 3 terms in each year shall be constituted as follows, in accordance with the Conditions of Service for School Teachers in England and Wales (the Burgundy Book):

the Summer Term from 1st May to 31st August the Autumn Term from 1st September to 31st December the Spring Term from 1st January to 30th April

<u>or</u>:

One week for each completed year of service up to 12 weeks if you have 8 years or more continuous service.

The minimum period you are required to give to terminate your employment is 2 months, and in the Summer Term 3 months' notice, terminating at the end of a school term. Whilst it may be possible for an earlier release date to be arranged by mutual agreement, a failure to work your prescribed notice period will result in the withholding of your salary.
